Art/Craft vendors \$40 indoor space approx.8x10 (limited) outdoor 12 x 12

Indoor spaces are limited and go quickly. Previous vendors have preference to these spaces but MUST have application and payment sent by July 1. After that indoor spaces are in order received. You will need to provide your own tent and set up for outdoor spaces. **Photos will need to be provided unless you were a 2022 vendor.**

Food Vendor Spaces \$125 which will include electric and water. You must supply water hose and electric cords.

Also, this year we will be a Shop Hop Friend with no special Shop Hop Hours.

There will be special vendor parking along the barn.

We will again host the civil war re-enactment with the Sherman Cannon and the Wm McKinley camp 21 SUVCW 1st Ohio Light Artillery Battery M.

Half of your entry fee is donated to this organization to help with ammunition. They will fire the cannon on Friday evening at 6 p.m. and on Saturday at 11 a.m. and 1 p.m. Jimmy's Jawbreaker will also be with us again this year.

We will have kid activities on Saturday including the pumpkin race and the corn cob throw. The petting zoo will return as well.

Friday night is our annual bean cook dinner. We invite all of you to attend as well as the public that is here that evening. It will start at 4:00 p.m. and continue until the beans are gone!!!!
